- 5. Grade 10 students must take at least 8 courses. Creative Writing and Literary Studies 10 (English 10), Socials 10, one Math 10 course, Science 10, Physical Health Education 10, and Career Life Education 10 are compulsory for all students in grade 10.
- 6. Students who completed Science 10 or Math 10 in grade 9 will replace these courses with grade 11 level courses.
- 7. Enter your course requests on the MyEd portal during the week of February 26-March 1, 2024.
- 8. Email your Counsellor once your MyEd course requests are entered. The portal will close March 4, 2024 and after that time you will only be able to make course request changes via your school counsellor.
