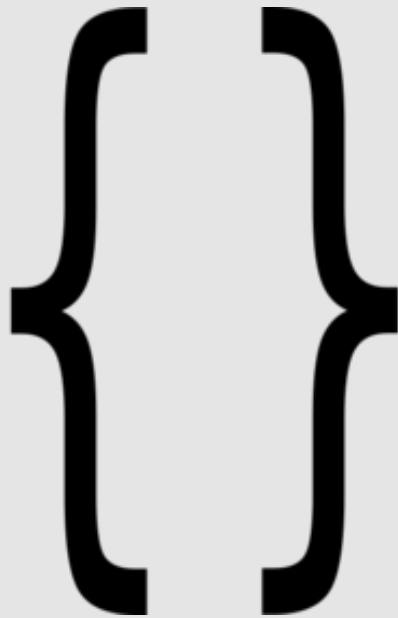
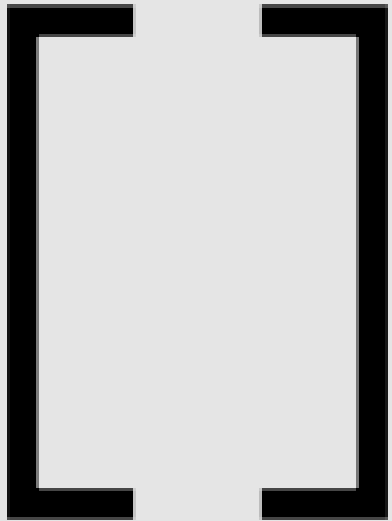

Brief History



- Parathesis comes from the Greek word which means injection or insertion. Another term for parenthesis is round brackets however it is not close in relation to square, fancy, and other types of brackets. When the word "parentheses" is translated from Greek it means "to put beside".



Rules for Punctuation

- There are a few rules on adding punctuation to parenthesis. One simple rule is there should be no commas after brackets. The next would be that if the first words in the sentence are enclosed in brackets then the punctuation would go inside the brackets. Another thing about punctuation would be that if the brackets are in the middle or at the end of the sentence then the punctuation should be placed outside the brackets (parenthesis). The last rule that would be listed is that the only punctuation that should be inside the brackets would be question (?) and exclamation (!) marks.
