

## **Storyboard That Tutorial**

Step one: Go into the 'Storyboard That' website and create a storyboard.

**Step two:** Begin with choosing a background for your story. If you click onto the 'Scenes' tab that is on the top, the highlighted part in the picture below provides varieties of different location to choose. Drag the photo into the box.




When you click your background, you can change the color of the objects.



**Step three:** Select a character of your choice by going into the 'Character' tab.




You can then design your character with the option that is given to you on the right.




Below filters, the edit pose tab enables you to change the characters action and expression.

**Step four:** To add speech bubbles, click 'Textables'. You can add colors, designs and an action bubble for your speech.

**Step 6:** Once you're done, make sure to save and provide a title for your storyboard.
