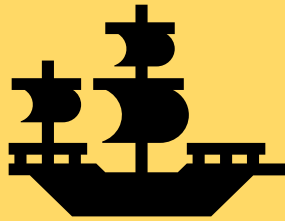


# My Summer Vacation in Cancun

# Music

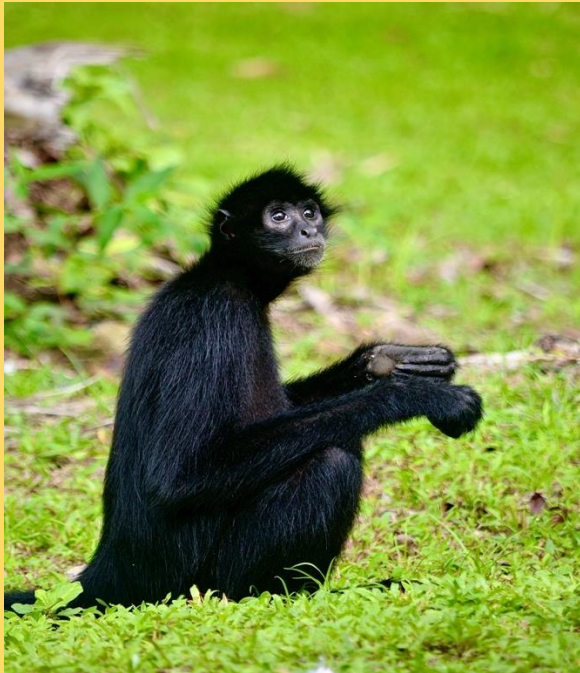
