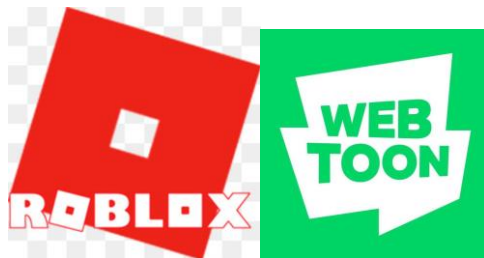


My Digital Footprint

Make sure you want to post something before you do, if you post something it can stay up forever, even if you delete it. People could record the image for example by taking screenshots, so think twice before posting content online. Don't overshare information, like if you say you're going on a picnic and you want to post a photo and tag it don't tag exactly where you are, or others could try to find your location.
